**Procedure E-001.15 - Career and Vocational Education**

---

The Superintendent recognizes the need to develop in all students a willingness to identify and make choices among life's alternatives. Students need assistance in understanding the significance of work in their lives, making career decisions and in preparing for careers. The Superintendent directs the staff to develop, in cooperation with the community, a program of information and services to assist students with post high school choices.

The school district is committed to basic and general education for students as the foundation for all careers. The school system shall encourage students to consider and explore as many options as possible in making career choices. Such encouragement may include development of decision making skills, opportunities for career exploration, accessible sources of career information, internships and selected job entry skills.
