**Procedure E- 001.17 - COMMUNICABLE/INFECTIOUS DISEASES**

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Parents/Guardians have the responsibility of reporting any of the diseases or conditions listed below to the school nurse:

Chickenpox	Influenza
Hepatitis	Mumps
Meningitis	Ringworm
Pneumonia	Strep Throat
Scarlet Fever/Scarletina	Whooping Cough
Tuberculosis	German Measles
Diphtheria	Measles
Impetigo	Pinkeye
Mononucleosis	Scabies
Poliomyelitis	Tetanus
Smallpox	Shingles
Coxsackie Virus	Haemophilus
Fifth Disease	Influenza
Head Lice	Vaccinia Disease
Salmonella	
SARS (Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome)	
Food poisoning confirmed by a physician	

If any student has a physician confirmed diagnosis of any of the above diseases or conditions, notice will be given to the School Nurse who will in turn notify the Board of Health. At the direction of the School Nurse Supervisor and/or the Board of Health, the School Nurse will inform families of the confirmed presence of the disease or condition in the school with recommended actions.
