**Procedure E-001.3 – ADULT AND CONTINUING EDUCATION**

---

The Board of Education believes in the importance of providing a range of educational opportunities for adults to continue their learning. The Superintendent shall provide adult education services in Americanization and United States citizenship, English for adults with limited English proficiency, elementary basic skills, and secondary school completion programs in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes. These programs shall be free of charge to eligible Greenwich residents. In addition, the Superintendent shall support a wide range of enrichment courses in such areas as the arts, business, foreign language, and recreation.

Continuing Education Program tuition will be adjusted periodically so that it offsets the instructional costs of the mandated and enrichment programs.

The Board of Education shall permit limited participation of adults in selected daytime courses at Greenwich High School on a space available basis.
